Ewa Pańkowska is a Senior Consultant of Pediatrics and Diabetology at Department of Pediatric Diabetology The Medical University of Warsaw. One of the largest Clinic, where is treated close to 1000 diabetes children and adolescents. Presently, she is a Secretary of Pediatric Section in Polish Diabetes Association. She studied Human Medicine at the University of Wroclaw and Warsaw and is specialized in pediatrics and diabetology.

Ewa Pańkowska is the initiator of insulin pump therapy in Poland and the Principal Investigator of Polish National Program – “Insulin Pump for young children”. In 1998 she coordinated The National DiabCare program, which was carried out in 30 polish diabetes pediatrics centers.

During last year she is a partner of the international Pediatric Pump Study Group, the recent pediatric ONSET-trial and the International Education program. In addition she is a co-author of numerous researches, published close to 30 papers and chapters of books and is an Author of guidelines for diabetic children. Presently she is a member of International Society for Pediatric and Adolescent Diabetes (ISPAD) as well as of American Diabetes Association (ADA). Currently cooperates with an international group on diabetes technology.

She is appointed as a consultant at the biggest Polish Charity Organization - Great Orchestra of Christmas Charity.
